

## Crime Bulletin - June 2019

### Brompton on Swale

- **05/06/19– Anti-social behaviour** – Reports of travellers staying near to the children's school bus pickup point and that one of the travellers was being rude and abusive towards the children whilst they were waiting for the school bus.
- **30/06/19 – Assault** – Reports of a staff member being assaulted at the community recycling centre.

### Scorton, Bolton on Swale

- **05/06/2019 – Suspect circs** – Reports of a suspect vehicle seen on the new housing development at Forest, seen from the site cctv. Following police attendance nothing had been taken.
- **09/06/19 – Criminal damage** – a vehicle was damaged whilst parked on High Row, Scorton.

### Dalton on Tees
